

ACTIVITY WORKSHEET FOR SCHOOLS

CAN YOU MAKE SOMEONE LAUGH THIS EASTER?

This spring, we're running a big intergenerational joke swap, with care home residents and young people sharing their favourite jokes.

HOW TO TAKE PART:

- 1. Photocopy the sheet with the egg-shaped templates. Pupils can then cut out the eggs. This can be on paper or card (but card would be better!).
- 2. Ask pupils to come up with their own joke, or think of their favourite rib-tickler, and write it clearly on the egg.
- 3. Decorate the egg however they would like! Colours, drawings, stickers, glitter... anything goes! As long as the joke can be read clearly.
- 4. Write their name and age on the back of the egg.
- 5. Snip on the cross at the top of the egg to make a hole.
- 6. The finished eggs can then be strung into a garland with string.
